## **PART ONE: THE INNER YOU**

In Part One of the interpretations you will read two sections concerned with your individual traits.

The first section describes your ego (sun), emotional make-up (moon), learning and intellectual orientation (Mercury), relationships and sociability (Venus), and the expression and focus of your physical energy (Mars).

The second section describes how well you deal internally with the external situations that you experience in life. Your capacity for happiness (Jupiter), ability to tolerate restrictions and frustrations (Saturn), how you are associated with or relate to new or innovative ideas and methods, and radical ideas and events that upset the status quo (Uranus), how you are associated with or affected by public ideals, morality, and spirituality (Neptune), and how you are associated with or affected by public policies toward crime, toward the power of government and industry, and toward exploration, development, conservation and distribution of natural resources (Pluto).

### **SUN**

The sun rules will power and ego. It is the core of your potential and uniqueness as an individual; who you are and what you are about. It represents the main direction and focus you want your life to take, and your determination to accomplish what you set out to do. It is your personal honesty and integrity, and the ability to command respect and authority, to impress and influence others.

### **SUN in ARIES**

As the first sign of the zodiac, Aries represents the first stage in the evolution of man and his place in the universe. The raw energy of life itself, which is the first step in being part of the universe, is evident in the character and make-up of Aries people. Babies think of themselves as the center of everyone else's universe. As they grow older, they learn that they are not the center but part of a family group. It is the karmic responsibility of the Aries-born to accept the idea that they are not the center of the universe but part of the larger social order of all men. Aries personalities who do not develop this kind of maturity are demanding and infantile in their behavior. They want what they want, when they want it. The vital life force that is their celestial heritage can either be used to inspire others as well as themselves, or it can be turned inward to reflect only their own selfish needs, and as a result, they fail to evolve as individuals.

Aries people are doers. They set out to accomplish things and are determined to succeed one way or another. The astrological symbol for Aries is the Ram and, considering the sheer force of energy and enthusiasm by which they accomplish their goals, it is not off the mark to suggest that they "ram" their way to success. They

must, however, learn the difference between being confidently aggressive--a responsible "take-charge person" on whom others rely to get things moving-- and being rudely aggressive-- a "know-it-all" who is insensitive to the feelings as well as the wisdom of others.

Aries individuals react in a physical way to everything they experience in life. That is, before they assess the practicality or worth of what they are doing, before they sort out their true emotions, and, before they take time to reason things out intellectually, their tendency is to shoot first and ask questions later. Their passionate nature is inspiring and flattering to others, but unless impatience and rash behavior are curbed, their unbridled enthusiasm backfires when they lose interest just as quickly as they gained it. Theirs is the astrological sign of the soldier but in their haste, they forget the practicality of being adequately armed before rushing headlong into physical or verbal combat. They quickly forget frustration and anger. Since theirs is essentially a generous nature, their selfishness is usually a result of carelessness rather than intentional unkindness.

Active, fiery Mars rules Aries and indeed, Aries people are high-spirited, energetic individuals ready to try anything at least once. Courageous, optimistic, and friendly, they are lively participants in the everyday bustle of life, maintaining a frantic pace others find difficult to match. Constant physical activity works off excess energy, and its vitalizing influence is important to their intellectual and creative endeavors. It is usually the energetic Aries who is willing to start projects others would be afraid to tackle. However, it is also Aries who often fails to finish things when too many details demand attention or they simply lose interest. In spite of the physical energy associated with Aries, they are not above using the inability of others to keep up with them as an excuse for their own idleness. If they expect others to provide them with constant stimulation and are unwilling to find their own diversions, they become lazy. Cut off from physical activity, they become depressed, unproductive, and overweight.

They are eager athletes and generous players. They enjoy the challenge of a tough contest, but they can be so stimulated that they become too aggressive. Aries rules guns and weapons, so it isn't surprising that many Aries individuals enjoy hunting. Combative by nature, they also enjoy boxing, wrestling, and most team sports. They are apt to be mechanically inclined and adept at arts and crafts, typing, working with machinery, playing musical instruments, or performing magic tricks. They have a tendency to allow their enthusiasm to exceed their actual ability. Before taking something apart, they don't stop to wonder if they can put it back together.

Aries colors are red and white. Vulnerable parts of the body are the head and face. As a sign of this celestial association, many Aries individuals are born with a birth mark on their head or face. Headaches, black eyes, nose bleeds, and insect bites are common Aries complaints. The birthstone for Aries is the diamond. The tremendous heat and pressure that nature exerts in turning carbon into hard, brilliant diamonds

represent the strength and physical force in the Aries-born. Flowers for Aries include the poppy (red), geraniums, honeysuckle, and hollyhocks.

## MOON

The moon rules desire as opposed to ego, need as opposed to expediency or reason. It describes how you feel about yourself, how you handle relationships, and how you emotionally respond to situations and experiences. It describes the flow of your daily functions; physical, emotional, and mental. The moon represents your residence and domestic environment. It rules babies and young children, your mother and other important females in your life.

## MOON in SAGITTARIUS

Those born with the moon in a Fire sign want to turn their feelings into physical experiences. They do not initially view their desires from the standpoint of practicality, emotional commitment, or as lessons to be learned. Before anything else there has to be action, some form of instant physical gratification. As lunar Fire sign personalities, those born with moon in Sagittarius are idealistic and romantic. Their risk-taking, adventurous spirit and magnanimous generosity are a curse as well as a blessing. It leaves them vulnerable to those who exploit their generosity, but it is also the combination of spirit and attitude needed for enormous success in enterprises that more cautious people would be afraid to try. They are open and honest with a tendency to be too candid at times, especially in situations that require a more diplomatic approach. Impatience can be the biggest stumbling block to success. They are not reluctant to make long-term emotional commitments, but relationships or situations that do not encourage them to retain a certain amount of personal freedom, are not likely to last long.

Sagittarius moon personalities are emotionally adaptable to changing circumstances and different relationships. A duality of nature makes them appear fickle and emotionally insecure while at the same time, steadfast, and independent. Readily impressed by those with power and status, they seek to associate with such people to increase their own advancement; one of their main goals in life. Concerned with making an impression on others, they may be guilty of inflating their knowledge and importance. Attracted to architecture, art and design many of them also have talent for mimicry and acting. For these lunar personalities, the best opportunities are in writing, teaching, performing, sales, education and communication.

Women with Sagittarius moon make better friends than lovers, though their restlessness may lead to many sexual adventures. Friendship is very important to them and their temperament is not well suited to domestic life. Men with Sagittarius moon are inveterate chasers of the ideal woman. Their emotional nature is uncomplicated, loyal, and at times, amazingly prophetic.

## **MERCURY**

Mercury indicates mental outlook, intellectual endeavors, the way you think and communicate. It represents ideas, methods, and information. It rules your hands and thus your manual dexterity and mechanical skills. Mercury also describes transportation; that is, how you get where you're going physically and mentally. Do you speed with all possible haste or amble along taking a few detours here and there?

### **MERCURY in PISCES**

The mental processes of those with natal Mercury in Pisces are influenced by their emotions. They find it hard to separate emotions from ideas and opinions, frequently allowing passion and idealism to overrule logic. Their mental orientation can be unstable, unrealistic, and overly spiritual. However, they may possess uncanny instincts and remarkable sensitivity to beauty and design. If supported by other strengths, they have a photographic memory, mathematical abilities, and sometimes more common sense than they are given credit for. When it comes to learning and transportation, it is apt to be their emotional strength or weakness that determines whether an individual forges straight ahead or ambles aimlessly from place to place at a snail's pace.

## **VENUS**

Venus rules your social attitudes and behavior, and your aesthetic tastes and inclinations. It is female relationships and social interactions at every level. Venus indicates your values. It describes romance, marriage and other partnerships, capacity for humor, and the pursuit of pleasure.

### **VENUS in ARIES**

Individuals with natal Venus in Aries rush to enthusiastically embrace relationships of all kinds. They enjoy having fun and some of their pursuits may involve an element of risk. Their passionate eagerness can be inspiring and contagious, but a penchant for undue haste sometimes results in being rude. The combative nature of Aries also means they can be too aggressive in forcing their attentions or affections on others. Their social instincts are friendly and, most of the time, attractively uncomplicated. Unwilling to take the necessary time to make proper evaluations, they are not very discriminating in their values and relationships. This is something, however, that can be overcome with maturity and guidance. They are not likely to seek a peaceful or mundane existence, preferring to be active and among people to find their inspiration.

## **MARS**

Mars rules physical energy and efforts. It describes the strength and direction of the physical force that drives your ego, fires your emotions, and encourages your mental endeavors and communicative skills. It describes male relationships and associations, risk-taking inclinations, and the physical challenges you are likely to

encounter.

## **MARS in TAURUS**

Individuals with natal Mars in Taurus are not likely to waste their time or efforts. Whatever they seek to accomplish or to acquire is consciously or subconsciously linked to satisfying a need for personal security. For most of them, it is usually in the form of money or other material assets. Even those who do not seek to amass material wealth become discouraged if their efforts and activities do not result in gaining some goal or tangible reward. Physical pleasures are often the object of their energetic pursuits. The Taurean influence gives these individuals patience and determination, and is also an indication of artistic skills. They are likely to possess great physical strength and stamina, or at least have the capacity to develop them.

## **JUPITER**

Jupiter rules your potential for growth and expansion on many levels; physical, intellectual, spiritual, cultural, and the accumulation of material assets, power, and status. It describes your optimism and aspirations. It represents your father and his position in society.

## **JUPITER in VIRGO**

♃ in ♍

Individuals with natal Jupiter in Virgo seek tangible proof of their growth and progress, or at least proof that what they are striving for makes some practical sense. They are very often just as involved with the progress and growth of others as they are with their own, which makes them excellent teachers, counselors or clerics. The idealism associated with both Jupiter and Virgo can be a severe limitation for these individuals when nothing and no one seems good enough or perfect enough to satisfy them. On the other hand, it is their demands for perfection that inspire others to rise above mediocrity.

## **SATURN**

Saturn rules responsibilities, restrictions and limitations you are apt to encounter, and the lessons you must learn in life. It does not deny or diminish imagination, inspiration, spirituality, and good fortune but it does demand that these things be given structure and meaning.

## **SATURN in AQUARIUS**

♄ in ♒

Individuals with natal Saturn in Aquarius are confronted with situations that in order to be successful need organization, dedication and stability, yet must also have room for freedom and original thinking. Somehow they have to effectively deal with the conflict between control and non-control. They are responsible for wise use of freedom, as well as accepting (or imposing) the rigidity of organization and discipline that are also necessary if anything is to be accomplished.

## URANUS

Uranus rules personal as well as societal freedom. It indicates originality of thought and expression. In society it rules radical ideas and people as well as revolutionary events that upset established structures. Uranus takes approximately seven years to transit one sign, taking about 84 years to complete all twelve signs. Since groups of people with Uranus in the same sign are separated by 84 years, the influence of this planet in a sign is generational. The personal implications of Uranus in your life are described by its house position and the aspects it makes with other planets in your natal chart. It describes areas of unpredictability, and where you or your life style may be different than those around you. It relates to the unusual or unique. Friends and associations to which you belong are also indicated, as is your potential involvement with science and technology, computers, and the media.

### URANUS in LEO

The generation of individuals born with natal Uranus in Leo are likely to be involved in the creative arts. They introduce their ideas with innovative flair and great boldness in defiance of traditional concepts. Leo is also associated with scientific research and humanitarian gestures, so these individuals may also be expected to attack old problems with new energy, ideas and methods.

## NEPTUNE

Neptune rules those who are oppressed or abandoned; the misfits of society. On a higher level it rules visionaries, and those who are glamorous and charismatic. It represents spirituality, mysticism, and ideals. Neptune is in one sign for approximately thirteen years, taking about 164 years to complete its cycle through all twelve signs. Since 164 years separate people born during its transit of one sign and those born when it returns, Neptune's significance in any sign is described as generational or historical. On a personal level, Neptune's house position and the aspects it makes with other planets in your natal chart will describe spirituality, abstract thinking, illusion, disillusionment, and other areas of your life where things aren't always what they seem. It rules derangement, guilt, persecution, and describes the potential for experiences related to confinement, abandonment, and addiction or physical intolerance to drugs.

### NEPTUNE in ARIES

For the mini-generation with Neptune in this forceful and instantaneous sign (1861-75,2025-38), things spiritual are associated with action and results rather than interior meditation or religious orthodoxy. Salvation comes from doing something about the situation to make it better and elevate those directly involved. The feeling that the spirit is fiery and does and should directly enter into your life is at the heart of the inner ideal. Whether it's tending to the needy or talking to the dead, you don't sit around and wait for something to happen, you get involved and make it so.

## **PLUTO**

Pluto takes approximately 248 years to make one cycle through all twelve signs. The period Pluto spends in each sign can vary from twelve years to thirty two years due to the eccentricity of its orbit. Like atomic energy (a force ruled by Pluto), the presence and direction of Pluto's energy are never obvious until it is used. Pluto's influence in any sign is interpreted as generational or historical. In your personal life, Pluto's significance is interpreted from its house position and the aspects it makes to other natal planets in your horoscope. Pluto rules intense energy, and describes the areas in which you consciously or subconsciously seek to exercise power or control. Pluto is also linked to your karmic responsibility, and in this respect, it describes the areas where you must gain the deepest level of understanding.

## **PLUTO in TAURUS**

Pluto's last period in Taurus was 1851-1882. Taurus is pragmatic and materialistic. During the period of Pluto in Taurus the application of physical scientific principles fostered the invention of machines that made industrialization possible. The meteoric rise of capitalism during this time was fueled by the unprecedented growth of industry and finance.

## **PART TWO: THE OUTER YOU**

In Part Two you will read about the twelve houses of the horoscope. The houses represent areas of life in which you operate on a daily basis. You will read descriptions of how you handle the circumstances you encounter in each of these areas, according to your nature, personality and other traits as they are outlined in Part One.

## **HOUSE 1**

The first house and the sign that rules the first house, which is also known as the Ascendant or Rising sign, describes your outer personality and physical attributes. To some extent it also describes your health and the type of illnesses you may experience.

## **CAPRICORN ASCENDANT**

♄ on 1st

A Capricorn Ascendant indicates individuals with energetic, success-oriented personalities, and determination to satisfy their personal goals. The shrewdness and open ambition associated with the sun or moon in Capricorn does not always show up so overtly in the personality of those with Capricorn Ascendant but these traits are present nevertheless. Most of them are very capable managers and supervisors, willing to accept responsibilities and positions of authority.

They strongly identify with the material world and tangible assets. Unless other factors in their personalities or backgrounds interfere, they are not likely to adopt easy-going, "take me as I am" attitudes. They feel more comfortable with formality.



They want to be aware of all the rules of social conduct and adapt their actions to fit these structures. Consciously or subconsciously they specifically choose the company of people who make them look good. It is not unusual for handsome Capricorn Rising males to select less attractive wives or, beautiful Capricorn Rising women to select less attractive female friends.

Capricorn is ruled by Saturn, planet of structure, restriction and longevity. It is often an indication of a difficult birth or restricted childhood. However, it doesn't matter what particular difficulties life presents to these individuals, their biggest challenge is always themselves. They are apt to be disappointed with some aspect of their personalities or appearance and may develop conflicting behavior to deal with these feelings when they surface. Some of these individuals practice strict self denial, while others abandon themselves to hedonistic pleasures as a form of self destruction. They may even exhibit both types of behavior. At every turn they confront fears and insecurity. How well they deal with the conflict marks their success as well adjusted adults. Capricorn ruling the first house raises the competitive spirit and by no means dictates the presence of a somber or colorless personality. On the contrary, it implies individuals who are apt to possess overcompensating cheerful personalities, and they willingly accept responsibilities and hardships which they are apt to feel they were born to endure. There is always a choice to be made, and the right one is never easy because it usually involves success which must be earned.

Capricorn Ascendant is usually indicative of abstemious eating habits which help these individuals avoid gaining too much weight. Sensitive skin, finely textured hair, brittle bones, and dental difficulties are apt to be their common physical complaints

## **SATURN in 1st HOUSE**

For those with Saturn in the first house, the biggest lessons in life involve self image. It doesn't matter what circumstances life presents the biggest challenge for these individuals is always themselves. Saturn indicates difficult circumstances surrounding birth and the early years of life. Whatever their childhood was like, these individuals are consciously or subconsciously disappointed by it and with themselves as well. Such inner negativity may result in their denying themselves any personal success or happiness, or they may completely abandon themselves to pleasure and other indulgences as a form of self-destruction. They feel they are unworthy, unattractive and undesirable, no matter what the mirror reflects or what others may tell them. At every turn they are confronted by their own fears and insecurities. How well they learn to deal with such personal conflict becomes a mark of their strength and success as an adult. Saturn in the first house may indicate inner turmoil but by no means does it indicate a somber or colorless personality. On the contrary, these individuals usually overcompensate by developing a cheerful demeanor. They are quite willing to accept hardship and responsibilities, which in most cases, they feel they were born to endure.

## **SATURN opposite URANUS**

Saturn opposite Uranus is a generational aspect that indicates fierce opposition between the old and the new, the liberal and the conservative elements of society. Compromise is rarely possible. When a winner is declared, there is usually no trace left of the losers or that which they represented.

## **HOUSE 2**

The second house describes material assets, how you handle monetary income, and the potential ways it may be earned. It also indicates the values and priorities you establish throughout life.

## **PISCES on 2nd HOUSE**

♆ on 2nd

Individuals with Pisces ruling the second house must preserve the things they value or risk losing them, in many cases even before they realize the danger. Unless their background in handling money efficiently is strong, they may find it difficult to keep financial affairs in order. One of life's biggest challenges will be to hold on to their incomes since there is a strong potential for bankruptcy, or at least the steady erosion of assets for one reason or another. Although a conservative attitude is wise, they have a tendency to go in one of two directions. They either pay little heed to finances and live on the edge of debt, or they develop such unreasonable paranoia over the potential loss of assets they can scarcely bring themselves to ever increase their assets through investment. Unless they are extremely organized, or have learned to become that way, they have a hard time setting or sticking to priorities. They may get sympathy, understanding, or monetary assets from the father, but whatever this parent provides it is (in many cases through misunderstanding) not what they may need most of all.

## **SUN in 2nd HOUSE**

☉ in 2nd

Sun in the second house indicates those whose personal identification in life is invariably tied to their material wealth, and just as important, to the prominence of their personal achievements and status. Sun in the second house is not a totally selfish influence. The goals of these individuals often benefit others as well as themselves, as in the case of those who seek to gain public recognition through charitable and philanthropic endeavors. How these individuals handle what they gain or lose, or even if they succeed in getting what they want, is determined by their ego. Goals they seek, priorities they establish, and values they embrace all tend to be what they want, not what is dictated by others.

## **SUN sextile SATURN**

☉ ♄ ♅

Sun sextile Saturn suggests individuals who may have to work a little harder to meet people who can help them, or encounter situations that can help them get ahead. However, with perseverance they nearly always succeed. It also may take a little more time before they either develop their goals or can actively pursue them, but

this too merely takes patience and preparation.

## **MERCURY in 2nd HOUSE**

**♀ in 2nd**

Mercury in the second house indicates those who seek to benefit in some tangible way from their mechanical skills or their ideas and information. As a result they earn income through communication, sales, education, writing, publishing, the design, installation and repair of machinery, travel, or transportation. They are adept at picking up on the priorities and value systems of others. Being able to know what others think is important can be a valuable asset. It makes them successful opportunists, though it does not necessarily imply they are manipulators or exploiters. Understanding and being able to make practical use of networks of all kinds is often their most valuable asset. Mercury's influence in the second house can mean they want (or are forced) to deal with the paper work involved with income and money. This includes those who cut out coupons from newspapers to those who handle financial transactions, loans, investments, bank books and other paperwork for their family; or work as bookkeepers, bank tellers or loan officers.

## **MERCURY opposite JUPITER**

**♀ ♂ ♃**

Mercury opposite Jupiter is by no means an indication of lack of intelligence. On the contrary, these individuals are apt to be exceptionally bright. However, Jupiter's involvement implies the tendency to collect knowledge to the point of dilettantism. The practical side of things is often left out of their thoughts. Intellectual snobbery is a temptation they can hardly resist, but they have an otherwise generous nature when it comes to sharing information and ideas. Inclination to pay attention to details is often totally absent but they can see and understand the big picture.

## **MERCURY sextile PLUTO**

**♀ ✕ ♇**

If there is no emotional afflictions in their personalities or backgrounds, individuals with Mercury sextile Pluto are apt to have keen perceptions and analytical abilities. There is no guarantee their endeavors will always be successful, but there is promise that if they take every opportunity to expand their intellectual capacities, their chances of success are almost certain.

## **HOUSE 3**

The third house describes your mental state, intellectual orientation, self-expression and communication, early education, mechanical dexterity and skills, immediate environment (neighborhood), and siblings. It indicates physical actions, and transportation, especially within your immediate environment. To a certain extent the third house also describes the job or health of your father.

## **ARIES on 3rd HOUSE**

**♈ on 3rd**

Aries ruling the third house indicates individuals with a healthy dose of intellectual curiosity. They want to know many things, but want to know it all at once. Impatience

with learning makes formal education confining. They dislike being subjected to long lectures and convoluted thinking, though they are not above engaging in such things themselves. Organization and mundane details present too much of a task and if their occupations demand this sort of attention, they may resort to hiring others for assistance. For them the most efficient method of learning is through actual physical experience. There is potential for an attraction (either positive or negative) to machinery, especially cars, and for mechanical skills. They are likely to have quick tempers. Those who possess more patience in learning as well as self-expression, are excellent writers or debaters. Never content with simple discourse and theory, they need to turn ideas into action. They may never get around to settling anywhere since one activity or another constantly draws them away from home.

### **VENUS in 3rd HOUSE**

**♀ in 3rd**

Venus in the third house indicates those who are very communicative and social, especially within their immediate environment. They have good relations with neighbors and actively participate in community projects. They have close, or at least very cordial relationships with siblings, and there is apt to be much visiting back and forth. Negative factors in their personality or background indicate disputes and other disagreeable situations with neighbors or siblings. The influence of Venus in the third house suggests fondness for books, and many of these individuals possess extensive book collections. It also indicates involvement in art, music, sales, diplomacy, banking, law, public relations, counseling, beauty, cosmetics, fashion, interior design, jewelry, or flowers. These same areas may also represent their father's employment. There is potential for partnership with a sibling, classmate, or neighbor.

### **VENUS conjunct NEPTUNE**

Venus conjunct Neptune implies deception and abandonment in romance. Though infidelity is possible, deception can also occur through false idealism. These individuals may have romantic involvement with those in the navy or maritime projects, dancers, photography, medicine, members of a minority. There is implication of artistic talent and creative imagination. They are sensitive and many of them possess remarkable intuition, except perhaps where their own romances are involved. They enjoy creating an aura of mystery and romance.

### **MARS in 3rd HOUSE**

**♂ in 3rd**

Mars in the third house indicates the likelihood of those with short attention spans. They have intellectual curiosity so they want to know many things, but unfortunately they usually want to know everything at once. Their impatience makes the structure of formal education very confining. They learn best through actual physical experience. Though they dislike long-winded lectures or convoluted thinking, they are not above engaging in these activities themselves. Taking care of details and organization can present too much of a task, and if obliged to pay attention to such

matters, they may resort to hiring or cajoling others to do it for them. They keep very busy, especially in their immediate environment or neighborhood with constant comings and goings. They are compelled to turn thoughts and ideas into action. Many of them never quite get around to settling down since one activity or another constantly draws them away from home. The negative potential includes those who are hot tempered, lack mechanical ability, and experience accidents, especially with cars and while traveling within a short distance of home. The influence of Mars on the positive side suggests writing ability, imagination, and talent for forensic debate.

### **MARS square SATURN**

Mars square Saturn indicates those apt to have impatience and inner negativity, which may not always reflect in their personalities. They often have a keen sense of humor and a ready laugh but are nevertheless what might be considered "straight arrows." They are usually ambitious, but their physical energy and enthusiasm may falter in the middle of a project, leaving the task of finishing to others. Sometimes it is a case of those who refuse to falter or give up, taking on all the responsibilities themselves or being forced to assume them.

### **MARS square URANUS**

Those with Mars square Uranus are bound to have a quirk or two. They veer from the traditional path from time to time, or perhaps make a lifetime project of seeking unusual or alternative life styles. They are willful and independent, and even those who settle down to marriage and regular jobs may grow restless and unhappy if too much confinement or control is imposed.

### **NEPTUNE in 3rd HOUSE**

♆ in 3rd

Neptune in the third house indicates those who are highly intelligent. They are, however, also apt to be mentally lazy, unwilling to explore areas of thought and ideas that appear to be too much work. They are not very anxious to be around strangers and people with whom they are not well acquainted. They enjoy watching others while remaining hidden or unobserved themselves. Neptune's third house influence includes potential for the father's occupation to be in the navy, maritime industry, chemistry, photography, footwear, religion, medicine, psychology, or areas that involve those who are disabled, institutionalized, or minorities. The father may suffer from hypochondria or hard-to-diagnose illnesses. Neptune in the third house includes individuals who form particularly sensitive, perhaps clairvoyant, relationships with their siblings, and those who experience untimely loss of siblings. The neighbors or siblings of these individuals may be involved with drugs or other illegal activities. Other potentials of Neptune's influence include those who suffer mental confusion, and those who rely too heavily on alcohol or other drugs to calm their fears and insecurities. It is necessary for these individuals to spend periods of time in a quiet, non-threatening environment. They may derive special benefit from being near the ocean. They often use pet names or aliases for themselves or their friends. Negative

factors in their personality or background can cause them to develop fear of water, or fears that prevent them from going very far outside their own neighborhood.

## **PLUTO in 3rd HOUSE**

**♇ in 3rd**

Pluto in the third house indicates those who develop singular powers of concentration, and are often very intense in the way they express their thoughts and ideas. As very keen observers, they miss very little of what goes on around them. Ability to concentrate their attention does not guarantee that they will apply it to scholarly pursuits, or that they have any real understanding of what they observe. It implies that they can present incredibly detailed descriptions of their observations. They consciously or subconsciously regard information as being useful in terms of the power it gives them over others. The old saying "mind over matter" is particularly true for these individuals. Though they may not choose to develop it, they possess remarkable mental ability to persuade themselves (as well as others) that something is true, whether it is or not. They enjoy secrets, mysteries, and intrigue. By choice or circumstance there may be some secrecy related to their communications, travel, siblings, and neighbors, or to their primary school experiences and/or their father's work or health.

## **HOUSE 4**

The fourth house describes your residence, domestic environment, and family members, especially your mother. It indicates the beginning as well as the end of various cycles in your life.

## **TAURUS on 4th HOUSE**

**♉ on 4th**

Taurus ruling the fourth house indicates individuals who feel more comfortable, and thus more sociable and romantic, in their own homes. Their homes are apt to have a very solid appearance and the interior is apt to contain a predominance of wood and leather. If the Taurean influence is given full expression, their homes are in a country rather than urban setting. They may develop interest or work in real estate, architecture, or interior design. There is possible inheritance, probably from their mother or mother's side of the family. They are apt to select marriage or business partners from among those who come from their home town. A fourth house Taurean influence indicates sociable, stable relationships with parents. It may also mean their mothers are particularly beautiful or have artistic talent. Negative potentials for Taurus on the fourth house include individuals who by choice or circumstances do not have homes, or are unable to derive enjoyment from domestic life and only use home as a place to camp out.

## **HOUSE 5**

The fifth house describes your creative talent and imaginative powers, capacity for enjoyment and the pursuit of pleasure, romance, children, and speculative ventures.

## **GEMINI on 5th HOUSE**

## **♊ on 5th**

Gemini ruling the fifth house indicates individuals who want to identify their creative personality with intellectual skill. In other words, they want the products of their imaginations or artistic skills to be more than just entertaining or beautiful to others. They want them to convey some special meaning or moral principle. A fifth house Gemini influence can mean they have special communicative skills, such as creative writing or the ability to flawlessly impersonate others. Though not above taking a chance on one throw of the dice, they are more apt to enjoy learning the real mechanics of gambling or trading stock and commodities. They may even devise a unique system of their own for gambling and other speculative ventures. They are romantically attracted to those with intellectual ability. A certain amount of fickleness in romance is highly possible since they have tendencies to engage in more than one affair at a time. As a rule, they take great interest in their children's intellectual accomplishments and enjoy helping them with their studies. They may be the parents of twins or be a twin themselves.

## **HOUSE 6**

The sixth house describes your job, daily responsibilities (paid and unpaid), and those who work for or with you. It also represents your health, and physical fitness.

## **CANCER on 6th HOUSE**

## **♋ on 6th**

Cancer ruling the sixth house indicates those with delicate or changeable patterns in their general health. This is not an indication of poor health, what it amounts to most of the time is that they have a tendency to experience medical complaints that are annoying but do not usually represent major illnesses. Many of them would prefer to work at home and pursue jobs or businesses they can successfully operate at home. There is also the possibility their work will be related to food, homes, domestic products or services, women, or children. They usually exhibit mothering instincts toward co-workers or develop strong emotional ties with them. As a rule they work better with women or children than with men, but the strength of that instinct depends on other factors in their individual natal charts. They may demonstrate inconsistency in work habits and perhaps in their ability to retain jobs. This characteristic is not necessarily related to poor attitudes or laziness on their part. Their health and psychological outlook are strongly affected by the type of work they do and when the working environment is not suitable for one reason or another, they may have frequent absences. On the other hand, if they derive emotional satisfaction from their jobs, they make excellent workers.

## **HOUSE 7**

The seventh house relates to marriage and partnership or joint ventures of any kind. It describes how you interact with people and how others tend to regard you. The seventh house is associated with legal matters, negotiations, contracts, and all open confrontations, pleasant as well as adversarial.

## **CANCER on 7th HOUSE**

**♋ on 7th**

Cancer ruling the seventh house indicates those who are often the beneficiaries of valuable assistance. Whether or not they ask for it, they engender strong, protective or nurturing instincts in others. When these individuals achieve outstanding success, there is a good chance it was not without impressive help from others. They are vulnerable to the influence of others, and though there are usually some differences between the type of influence a seventh-house Cancer has on males as opposed to females, the influence can be interchangeable in one form or another. In a male's chart, it indicates he is likely to select a wife who strongly resembles or exhibits the characteristics of his mother. He may marry a woman that adopts a mother's role toward him as well as that of a wife. It is also possible he will marry someone younger than himself. A female with this Cancerian influence usually exhibits strong emotional identification with her husband. She will be dominated by marrying a man with a forceful nature, or indirectly dominated by his money or status. Even if the marriage fails, she may have difficulty finding psychological release from her relationship. The positive side of Cancer's influence is the potential for close, loving relationships.

## **URANUS in 7th HOUSE**

**♅ in 7th**

If these individuals manage to accomplish a long and stable marriage, they can count themselves fortunate. The influence of Uranus in the seventh house rarely allows such peaceful or uninterrupted alliances. There is likelihood of more than one marriage or, in some cases, their need for personal independence discourages marriage altogether. There is also the possibility that they may marry suddenly and unexpectedly, or that marriage may be abruptly terminated. Their marriage partner or the marriage itself may be unusual or unorthodox, or at least considered to be unusual in their particular society. These individuals possess natural poise and ability when it comes to relating well to others. Strangers usually feel so comfortable on meeting them, that they feel they have known these individuals for a long time. The potential influence of Uranus in the seventh house suggests those who, for one reason or another, appear unusual or different to others. In turn, these individuals can expect to encounter more than their own share of strange or unusual people. Cooperative efforts, joint ventures, and partnerships may be unusual; or they may be established in unorthodox ways or for unusual reasons.

## **HOUSE 8**

The eighth house is related to taxes, debt, death, legacies, and the income you receive through marriage or business partner(s). It describes your resourcefulness, and your ability to develop and use material assets as well as personal skills and abilities. The eighth house also indicates sexual attitudes and behavior.

## **VIRGO on the 8th HOUSE**

**♍ on 8th**

Virgo ruling the eighth house indicates the likelihood of those concerned with



personal resources and how these resources might be put to better use and improved. It also suggests that they or their marriage partners may be involved in stock market and commodity investments, tax matters, insurance, or in handling the financial affairs of others. The negative potential of Virgo's eighth house influence implies the possibility of experiencing unfortunate circumstances in financial matters, or that these individuals are continually bogged down in details and responsibilities regarding them. It also indicates they may give more time and attention to analyzing how sexual situations can be turned into ideal experiences (or at least improved according to their personal standards) than they do to physical enjoyment. Satisfactory sexual relations may require as much mental stimulation as physical excitement. On the positive side however, it can mean individuals who have outstanding research or counseling talent.

## **JUPITER in 8th HOUSE**

Jupiter in the eighth house indicates those who feel that a vital part of their independence (and importance) as an individual depends on making the most of their material and non-material resources. They may be very interested in the stock market, handle investments for others, or be involved with taxes, insurance, and estate planning. Jupiter in the eighth house is also an implication of remarkable recuperative powers. The potential involves more than recovery from physical illness, it includes emotional upheavals, financial setbacks and other disappointments or failures. Eighth house Jupiter refers to the possibility of a wealthy marriage partner, but it also implies that their partner's income may be derived through writing, publishing, politics, law, foreign trade, or education. The negative potential is that the expansiveness and optimism of Jupiter can mean wasted resources and the accumulation of monumental debt.

## **JUPITER trine PLUTO**

Jupiter trine Pluto implies a generation that can adequately integrate power with sensitivity in societal and political structures. This does not occur automatically, but the influence seems to put the right people in the right place at the right time.

## **HOUSE 9**

The ninth house describes higher education, advanced training, publishing, publicity, advertising, politics, foreign travel, foreign studies, religious and philosophical views and activities, and cultural pursuits. It relates to court decisions, a second marriage, and in-laws. To a certain extent the ninth house also describes the job or health of your mother.

## **LIBRA on 9th HOUSE**

**♎ on 9th**

Libra ruling the ninth house increases the likelihood of being culturally oriented, spiritually inspired, literary-minded, musical, or philosophically and intellectually disposed. These individuals may like to think of themselves as citizens of the world,

and if their various social and intellectual interests are allowed full expression, they may indeed fit such a description. The Libra influence signifies they may be judges, legislators, teachers, musicians, artists, or work in communications, foreign service or international law. The negative potential can mean antisocial or prejudiced attitudes, trouble with in-laws, or unfavorable court judgments. It also implies individuals with difficulty obtaining advanced degrees or so many degrees they become dilettante scholars. Though there is potential for overly idealistic or impractical notions regarding religion and social structures, Libra's influence suggests these individuals will strike a balance between their ideals and practical reality. There is the possibility of romance or marriage in a foreign country or with a person of a different race or culture.

## **HOUSE 10**

The tenth house describes your career and other long-range goals, public reputation, superiors and those in authority. It also relates to your father and his influence in your life.

### **SCORPIO on 10th HOUSE**

**♏ on 10th**

Scorpio ruling the tenth house is an implication of those who are apt to suffer some traumatic event in youth that greatly affects them as adults. The trauma may have been the death of a parent, or physical or mental abuse by a parent or other family member. There may have been a suicide or other deeply troubling incident related to friends. No matter what the reality of their childhood, somewhere along the line they manage to develop the sense of having no control over things. As a result, they have great reluctance to allow anyone else to assume control over their lives and destinies. If for one reason or another, they do relinquish such control, it can be a significant impediment to their growth and maturity. There may be a complete change of career for them later in life. There is also implication that, if they do not gain public attention and power themselves, they attract friends and associates who gain such positions. Whether by choice or circumstance there is often an element of mystery or secrecy connected with their careers, public image, their fathers, or the background of their marriage or business partners.

### **MOON in 10th HOUSE**

Moon in the tenth house indicates individuals who consciously or subconsciously seek public acclaim. Someone in their family may achieve fame (or at least notoriety). Though all of them may not be able to claim widespread fame, they often gain limited public recognition as a lecturer, cleric, business leader, politician, or public official. These individuals may care more for keeping up appearances than they do about what happens to them privately. The moon's influence implies emotional satisfaction through a career or long-range goals. It also includes those who participate in a family business or follow the same career as that of a parent. Even those who devote themselves to home and family gain emotional feedback, renewed energy, inspiration

and enthusiasm from being out in public.

## **MOON trine URANUS**



Moon trine Uranus indicates those with remarkable poise, ability to handle many difficult or unusual situations with understanding and aplomb. Intellectually curious and keenly intelligent, these egalitarian individuals can emotionally identify with people everywhere and from all levels of society. Emotional attachments may be unpredictable and erratic but rewarding and unique sources of their personal growth.

## **HOUSE 11**

The eleventh house rules friendships, organizations to which you belong, and income derived from self-employment or career (as opposed to wages earned from a job). It relates to the role you play in the lives of others as child, parent, lover, spouse, friend, social or business associate. The eleventh house also describes your hopes and aspirations and capacity for happiness.

## **SAGITTARIUS on 11th HOUSE**



Sagittarius ruling the eleventh house indicates those whose friends and acquaintances help them achieve important advancements as well as personal growth. It also suggests those with a tendency to make far more friends and acquaintances than a single lifetime can reasonably afford. Their friends are apt to include intellectuals, travelers, artists, clerics, people connected with the theater, and those of a different race or culture. There is the strong possibility they may attach far more importance to friendships than is necessary. They are also apt to feel they are friends with someone even though in reality their association with that person may consist of nothing more than a single brief meeting. The other unfortunate implication is that with the expansive nature of Sagittarius, these individuals may find it difficult to ever be content with anything, always wanting more than what they have. The positive influence on the other hand, means that much happiness and joy is derived through friends and associates, and the enhanced capacity for being optimistic and happy no matter what life brings.

## **HOUSE 12**

The twelfth house describes the private and hidden side of life; your subconscious mind, dreams, the past, and those who wish you harm or work against your interests. The twelfth house relates to sorrow, disappointment, loss, solitude or confinement, hidden fears and worry. It also has connection with the job or health of your marriage or business partner.

## **CAPRICORN on 12th HOUSE**



Capricorn ruling the twelfth house indicates the likelihood of individuals who voluntarily or involuntarily spend much time alone. They may have outgoing personalities and many friends, but one circumstance or another forces them into

solitude. They may also have such fear of being alone that they actively seek to avoid it at all costs. There is also implication their marriage partners may have difficulty finding employment, or jobs that entail many responsibilities which becomes another reason why these individuals may have to spend time alone. There is also a possibility their marriage partners will suffer from lingering or chronic illness. Success is possible, but gaining true recognition for what they do may be difficult. They are apt to be victims of unfounded fears and unnecessary worry. Though their curiosity about psychic phenomena and the occult may be keen, they don't really want to know the future, at least not their own future. They are, however, quite ready to study the past, and from their understanding of it, build the structure by which they can effectively deal with the present.
